## STEPS FOR AFFILIATION IN THE FLD/EFCA

This guide will provide you an overview of the process for becoming one of our affiliated churches. We look forward to hearing from you!

## **PHASE 1: Exploration and Confirmation**

- 1. Read content on the theology, culture and offerings of the EFCA and FLD
  - a. READ: The Benefits of Affiliation
  - b. READ: FLD Website on Credentialing & Other Ministries
  - c. READ: The EFCA Statement of Faith
- 2. Church leader(s) connect with district leaders for Q&A
- 3. Elder team (board) affirms moving forward
- 4. Congregational membership connects with district leaders for Q&A
- 5. Congregation affirms moving forward

## **PHASE 2: Forest Lakes District Affiliation Steps**

- 1. Amend church constitution as needed to include
  - a. EFCA Statement of Faith
  - b. Membership in the Forest Lakes District of the EFCA
  - c. Dissolution Clause that frees assets in event of closure for future church planting
- 2. District representative(s) visit(s) the church, congregation and leaders
- 3. Constitution-bylaws are reviewed by FLD leaders to confirm alignment
- 4. Final version of governing documents affirmed by elders and members
- 5. Affiliation application with the FLD filled out by church pastor and/or elder
- 6. FLD Board votes to affirm church to district delegates
- 7. Informational announcement regarding church is shared with the district (2 weeks or more before District Leaders Conference)

- 8. Church leaders are presented and prayed for during conference followed by a vote to affirm membership
- 9. Church leadership is notified regarding vote and presented a certificate of membership in the FLD
- 10. Church and leaders are added to church communication channels of the FLD

## **PHASE 3: Evangelical Free Church Affiliation Steps**

- 1. Affiliation application with the EFCA is filled out by church pastor and/or elder
- 2. EFCA National sends the church their 501(C) (3) determination letter under the EFCA
- 3. Church is added to the communication channels of the EFCA
